

We started off really busy. While having 15 quilts in the house, we were asked for 138 by the end of February. These would have had the presentations spread out into July 2020.

Most of these groups (that requested quilts) are still not meeting in person. I've spoken with them and they don't know when they'll resume their in-person meetings / presentations of quilts.

One of the people requesting quilts was Dennis Hawkins (Airdrie Legion). We have now completed all of his requests.

I have six requests for quilts that I'm working to get presentation dates for. On the Dashboard, I have 83 presented. By the end tomorrow, we will add four more. We currently have 241 quilts registered in for 2020.

Our average for presenting quilts is 130-150 per year. In 2019, we presented 232 quilts. We were hoping to reach out to 200 plus veterans in our area for 2020.

We have shared 16 plus 4 (waiting for labels and binding) quilts to Nicki.

We have 18 requests for Colonel Belcher. I'm verifying they have not already received a quilt. There is new recreation staff and they have confusing historical data to work with. I'm using Sandy's and my records. Once I have all the names checked, I'll submit the 18 requests for quilts. The Recreation Staff will be presenting these on our behalf.

We have a few new military reps that we will be working with to get quilts to their peers.

We have gone from : sew days -- to staying at home all the time -- to trunk shows in parking lots with our masks on. We are going to try indoors with lots of space and masks for our October show and tell meetings.

I'm looking forward to teaming with Pam and Nicki to see what we can accomplish for our veterans in our areas.
